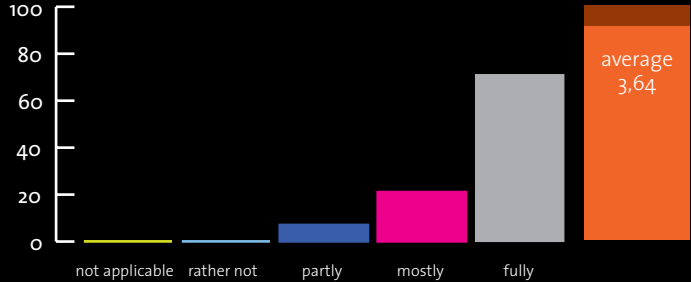

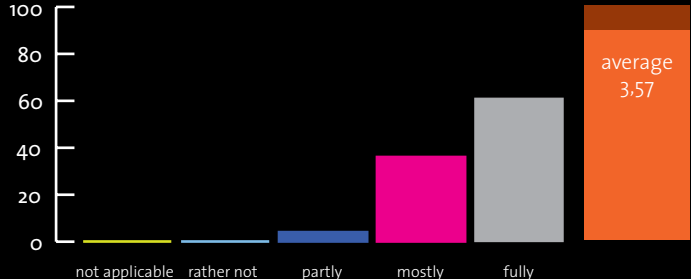

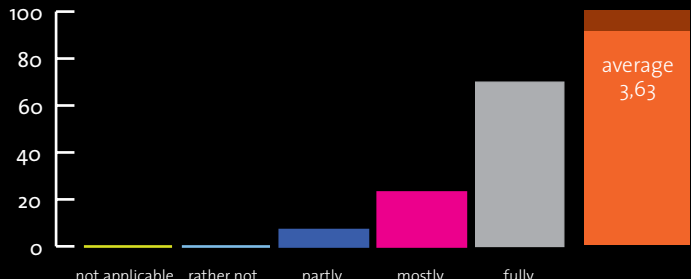
### 5.2 Impact measurement - quantitativ results



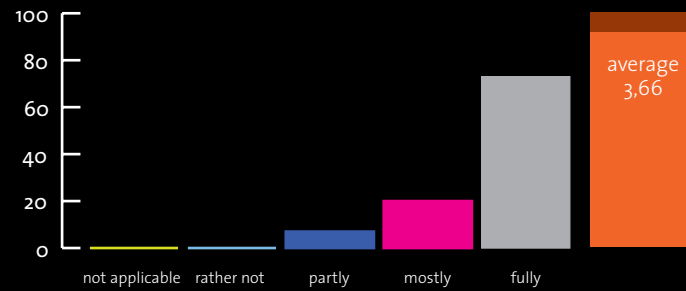
**Statement 1:**  
In the project I have learned to listen more closely to others.



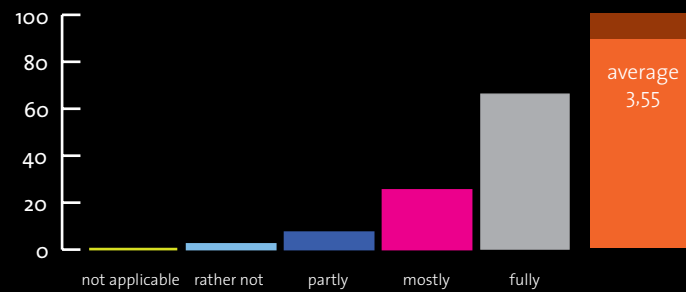
**Statement 2:**  
In the project I have learned to express my opinion.



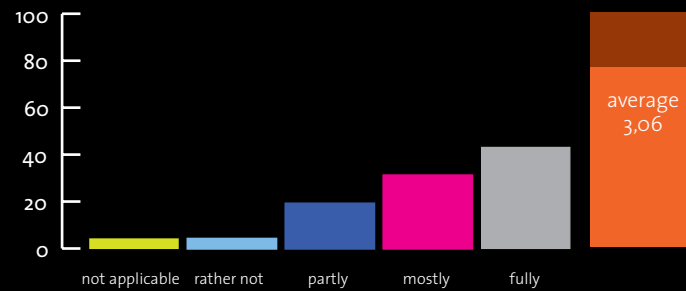
**Statement 3:**  
In the project I have learned to respect others' opinions, even if I have a different opinion.



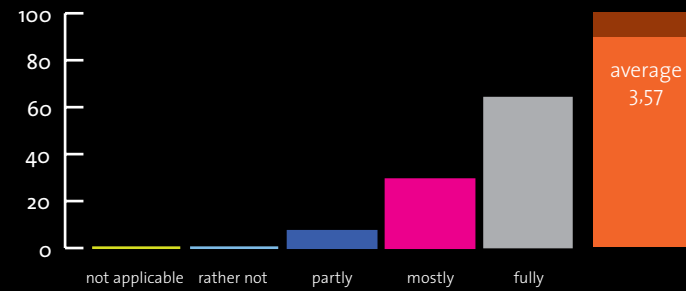
**Statement 4:**  
In the project I have learned to find rules with the others that are ok for everyone.



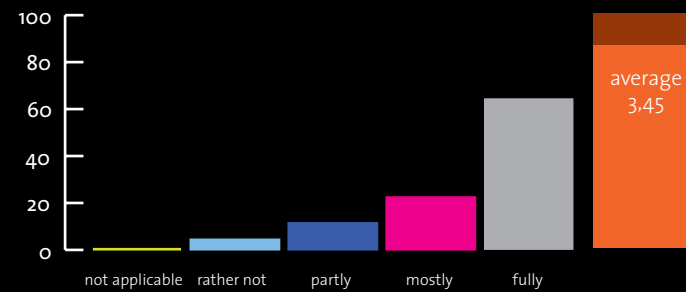
**Statement 5:**  
In the project I have learned to talk to each other and find solutions, if there is a conflict.



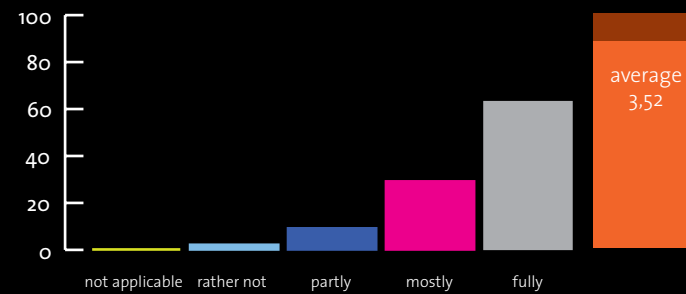
**Statement 6:**  
In the project I have learned to be responsible for tasks.



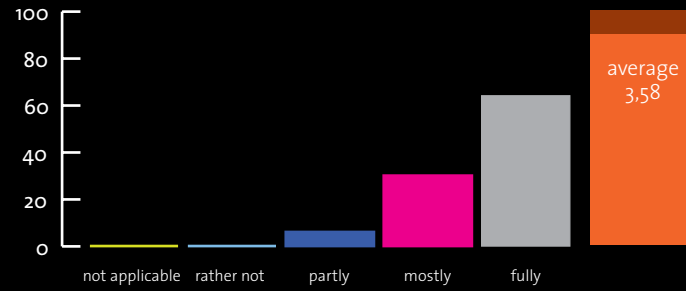
**Statement 7:**  
In the project I have learned to better work in a team.



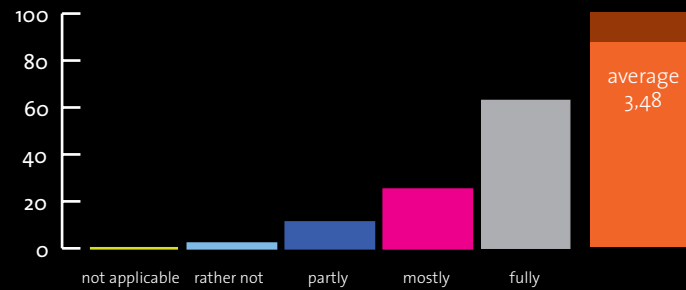
**Statement 8:**  
Since I participate in the project I have discovered, what I'm good at (e.g. organizing, talking in front of others).



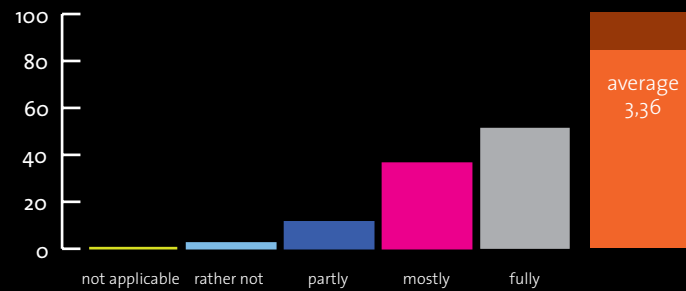
**Statement 9:**  
Since I participate in the project I dare to do more (for example to report myself for difficult tasks).



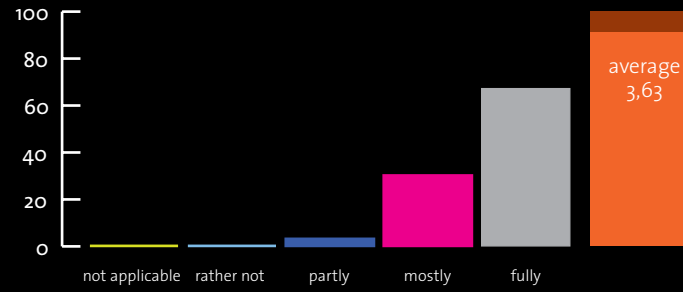
**Statement 10:**  
Since I participate in the project I have become more confident.



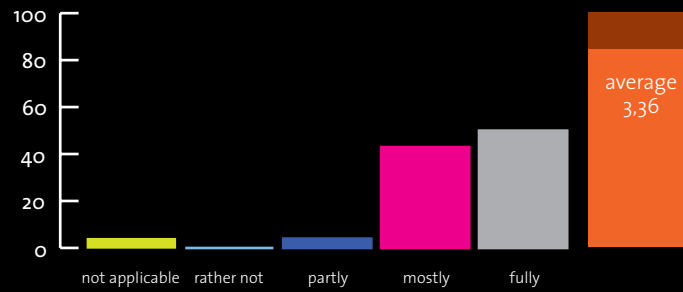
**Statement 11:**
